**NOTICE**

TAKE NOTICE that a petition (the **Petition**) has been presented to the High Court of Ireland (the **Court**) seeking approval for a scheme for the transfer of non-life insurance business of Golden Arches Insurance DAC (**GAIDAC**), having its registered office at Third Floor, The Metropolitan Building, James Joyce Street, Dublin 1, Ireland to Zürich Versicherungs-Aktiengesellschaft (**Zurich**) having its registered office at Leopold-Ungar-Platz 2, 1190 Vienna, Austria (the **Scheme**). The business which is proposed to transfer under the Scheme consists of a portfolio of non-life insurance policies underwritten by GAIDAC between 1993 and 2020 (the **Policies**).

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that a copy of this Notice, the Petition (incorporating the said Scheme) and an actuarial report on the Scheme (the **Actuarial Report**) will be available for inspection by the policyholders/insureds and shareholders of GAIDAC and Zurich at their respective registered offices between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. local time for a period of at least fifteen working days from the date hereof. copy of that affidavit on A&L Goodbody LLP at the aforementioned address to arrive no later than 5.00pm on 3 October 2024.
